- Provides short-term individual and/or group counseling for students regarding school-related concerns
- Collaborates with administrators, teachers, and staff on student needs
- Utilizes evidence-based tools to respond to student safety concerns on-site during school hours and facilitates the referral process
- Provides training to staff regarding counseling issues (confidentiality, mandatory reporting, general psychoeducation, suicide prevention)

Cultivate Positive Relationships with Children and Families

- Develops and maintain rapport with students and parents
- Represents Cherry Hills Christian in a favorable and professional manner
- Provides referrals, parenting resources and psychoeducation to families
- Advocates for the importance of mental health through parent and community communication (Lion's Link, Counselor's Corner, Parent Council)
- Creates opportunities for informal interactions and availability to students as needed
- Ensures accurate and timely response to communication requests
- Respects professional ethics that require confidentiality concerning the sharing of information about children, parents or staff including maintaining confidential documentation of direct counseling services according to the HIPAA standards
