

PRESCHOOL DRESS CODE GUIDELINES | 2025-2026

Our preschoolers are busy learning through play, creativity, and movement every day! To help them stay safe, independent, and comfortable, please follow the dress guidelines below, ensuring that you **label everything**:

Everyday Clothing

- Avoid onesies, rompers, or overalls kids need easy-on/off clothes for toilet independence.
- Choose comfy, play-ready clothes children can manage themselves.
- No spaghetti straps, halters, or tops that slip off shoulders.
- Girls wearing dresses/skirts must wear shorts underneath.
- Dress for the weather layers are best.

Footwear

- Shoes must be closed-toe and securely fastened.
- No Crocs
- No heels, flip-flops, heels, heeled boots, or open-toe sandals.
- In cold/wet weather, students may wear weather-appropriate boots. Teachers may also request that students bring a clean pair of indoor shoes.

Extra Clothes

• Always pack a full spare outfit (shirt, pants, underwear, socks, and shoes).
